How and why the report was generated: The national census data included in this report gives a comprehensive overview of diversity on a country-wide scale. This is to support you to contextualise and reflect on the diversity of your organisation. While the census data shouldn't be treated as a benchmark for a 'level' of diversity your organisation needs, it can be a valuable tool for prompting questions about your organisation's make up. By reflecting on these figures, boards can foster a more inclusive culture and identify areas for improvement in their diversity and inclusion practices.

The report contains anonymised data for all boards in this organisation. It only includes information about people allocated to a board's constitution on GovernorHub.

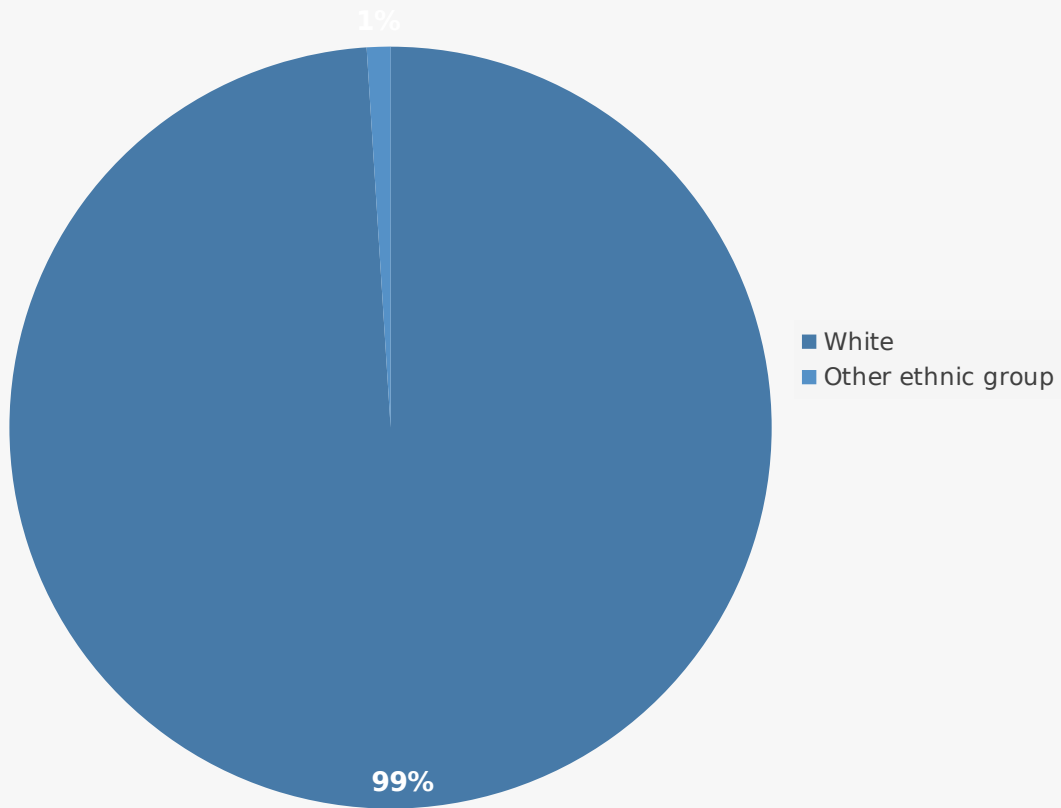

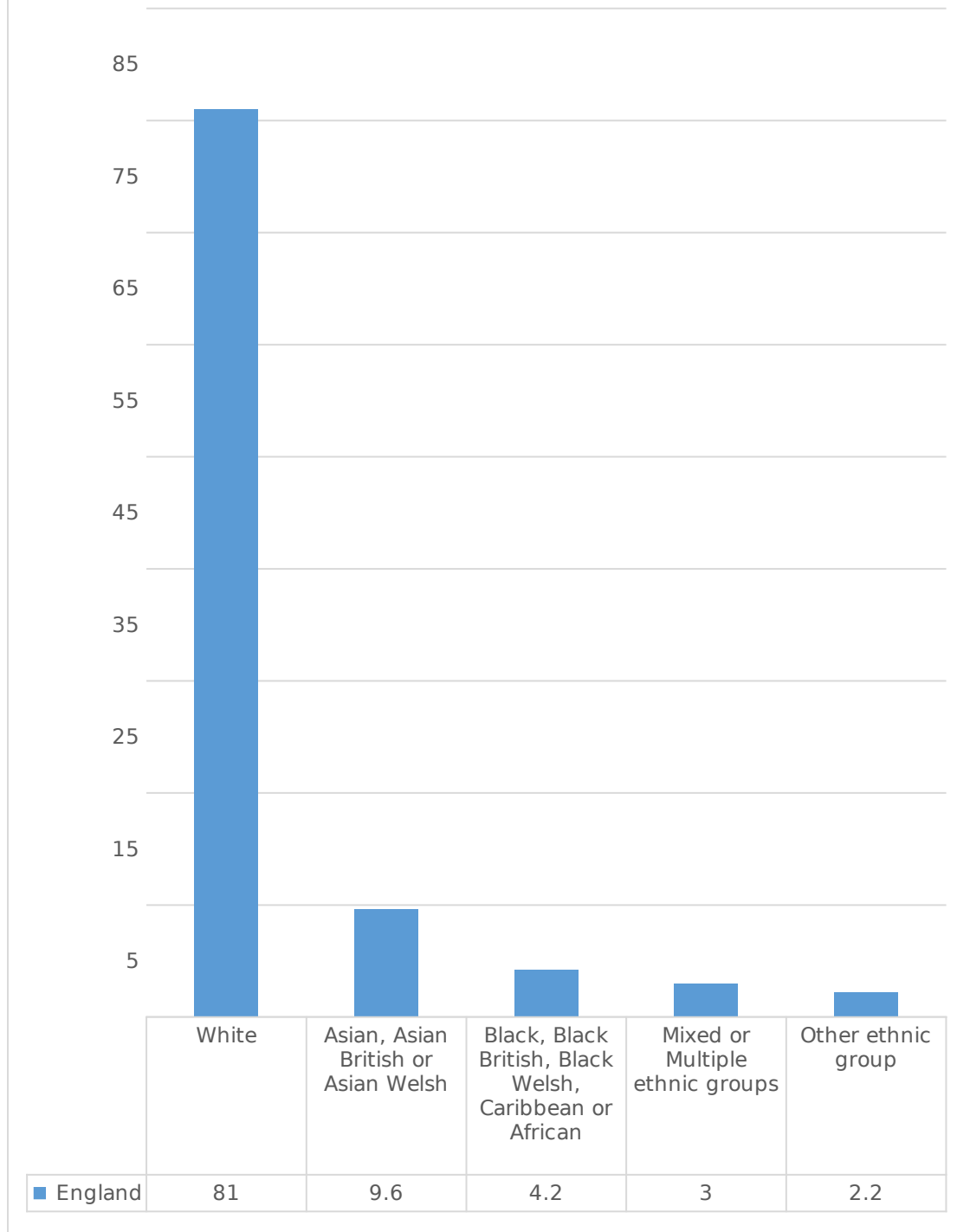


What is your ethnic group?

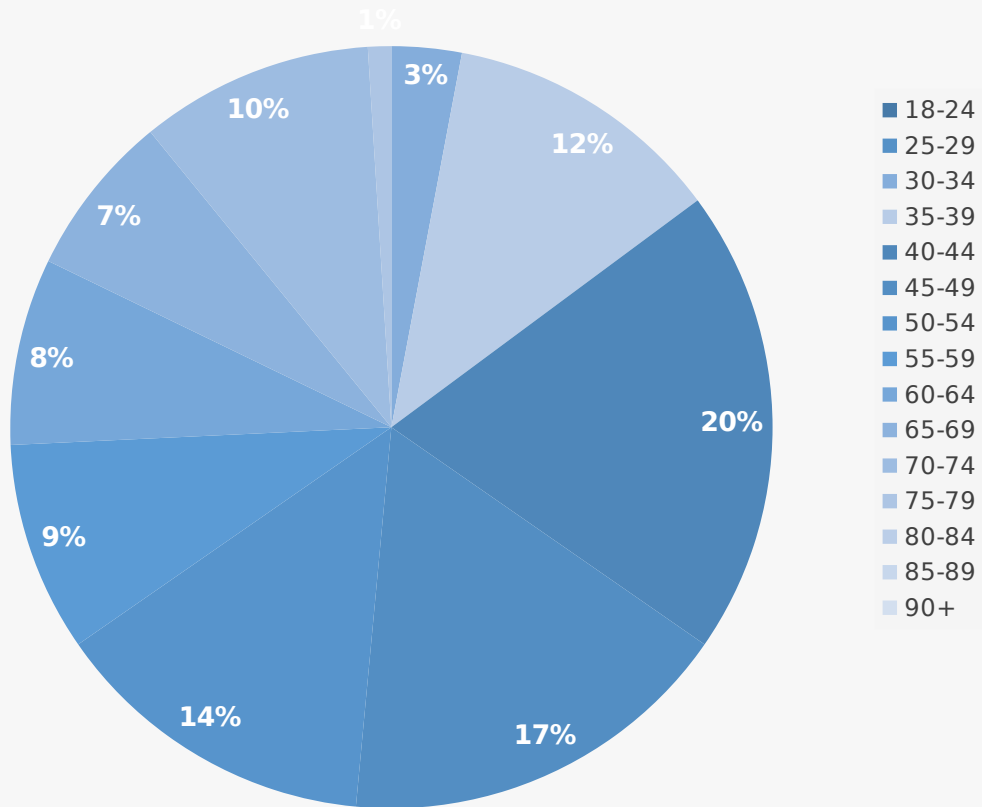

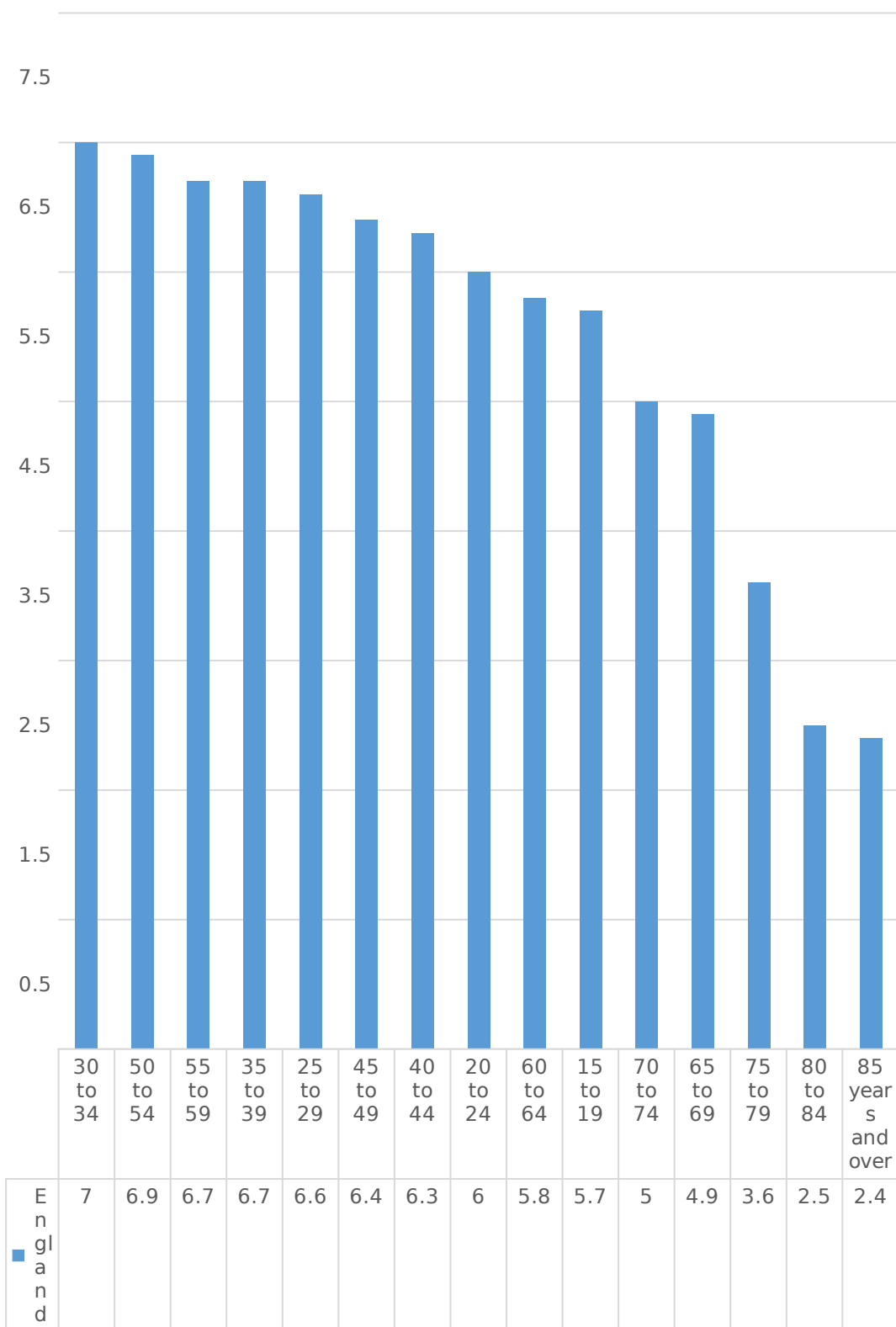
Percentage of governors by age band



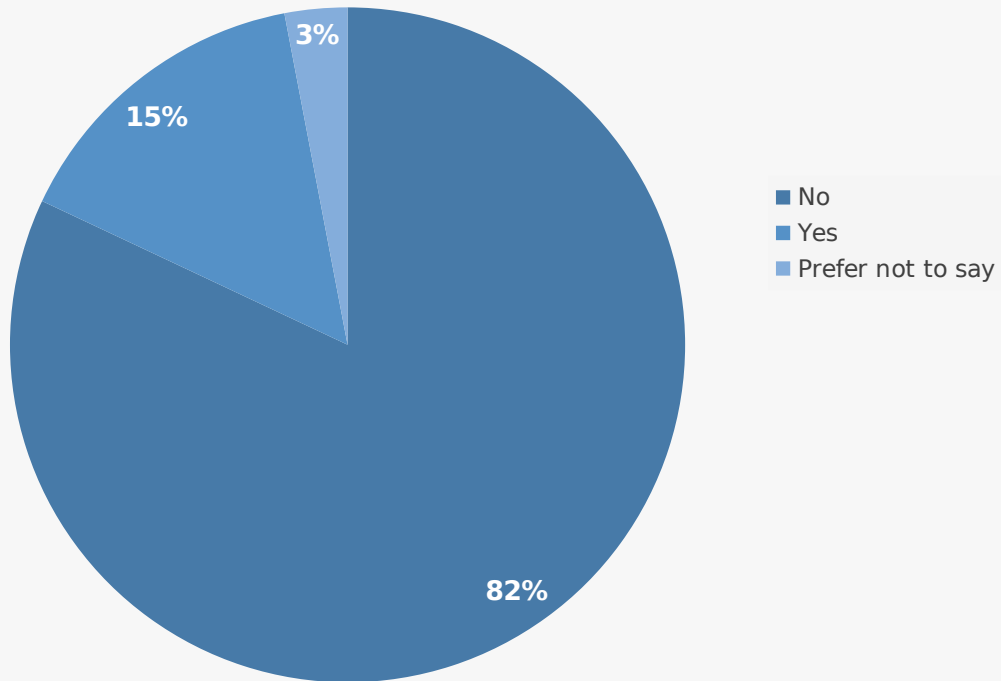

Census data: Age by five-year age band



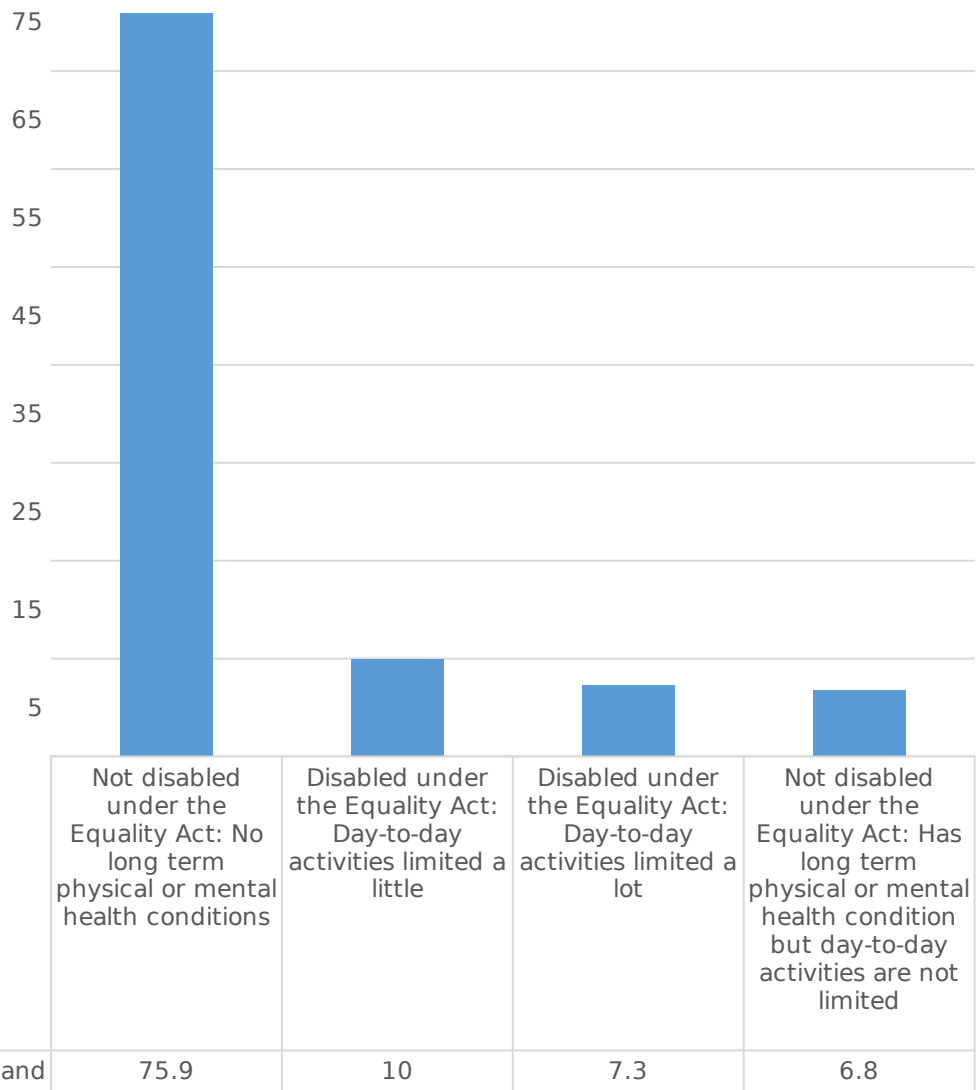

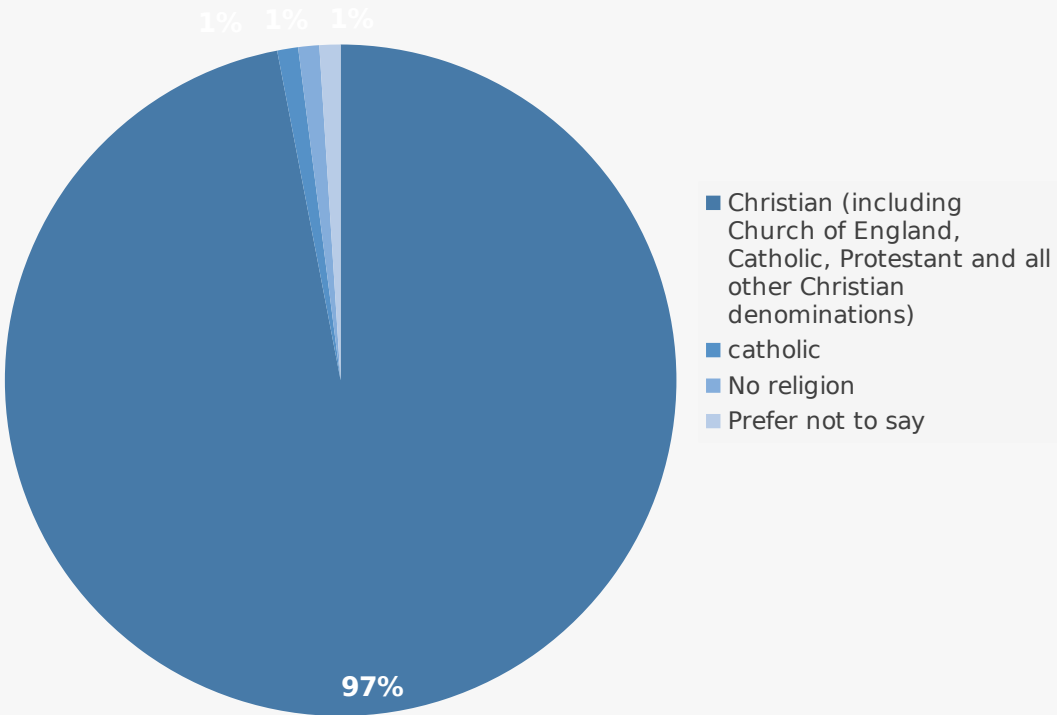

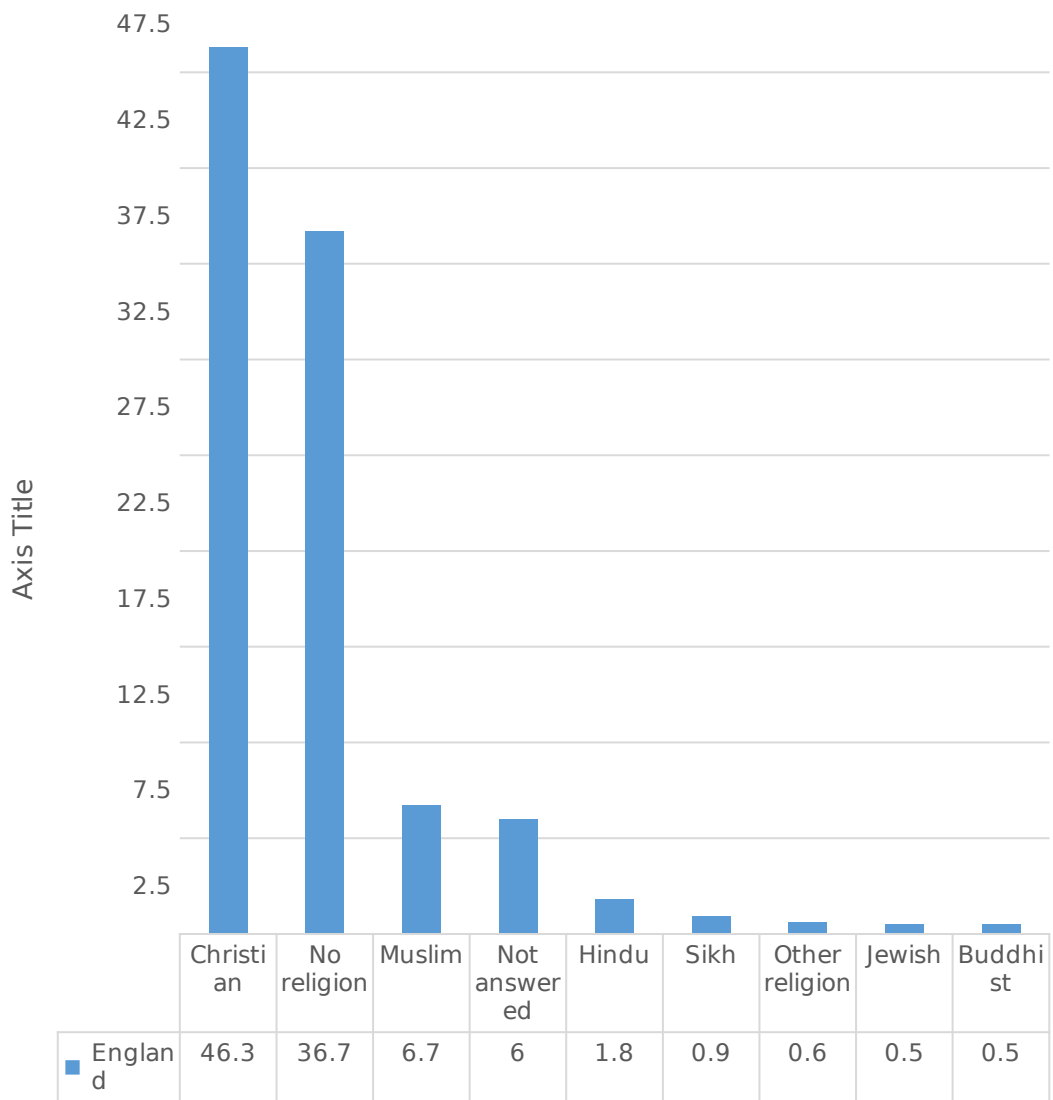
What is your religion?



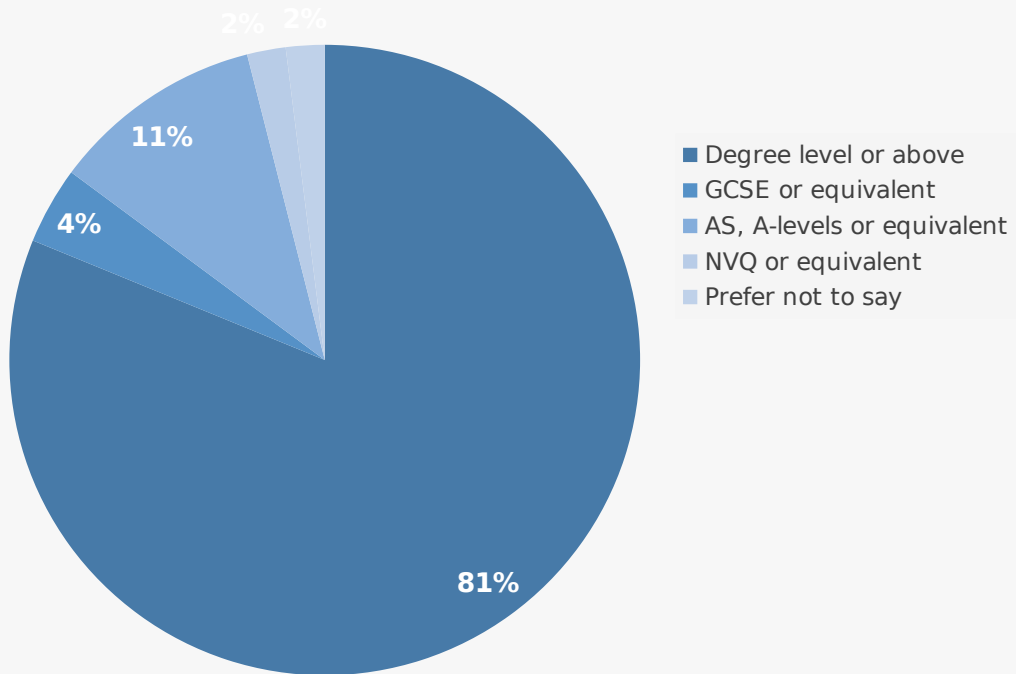

Census data: Religion



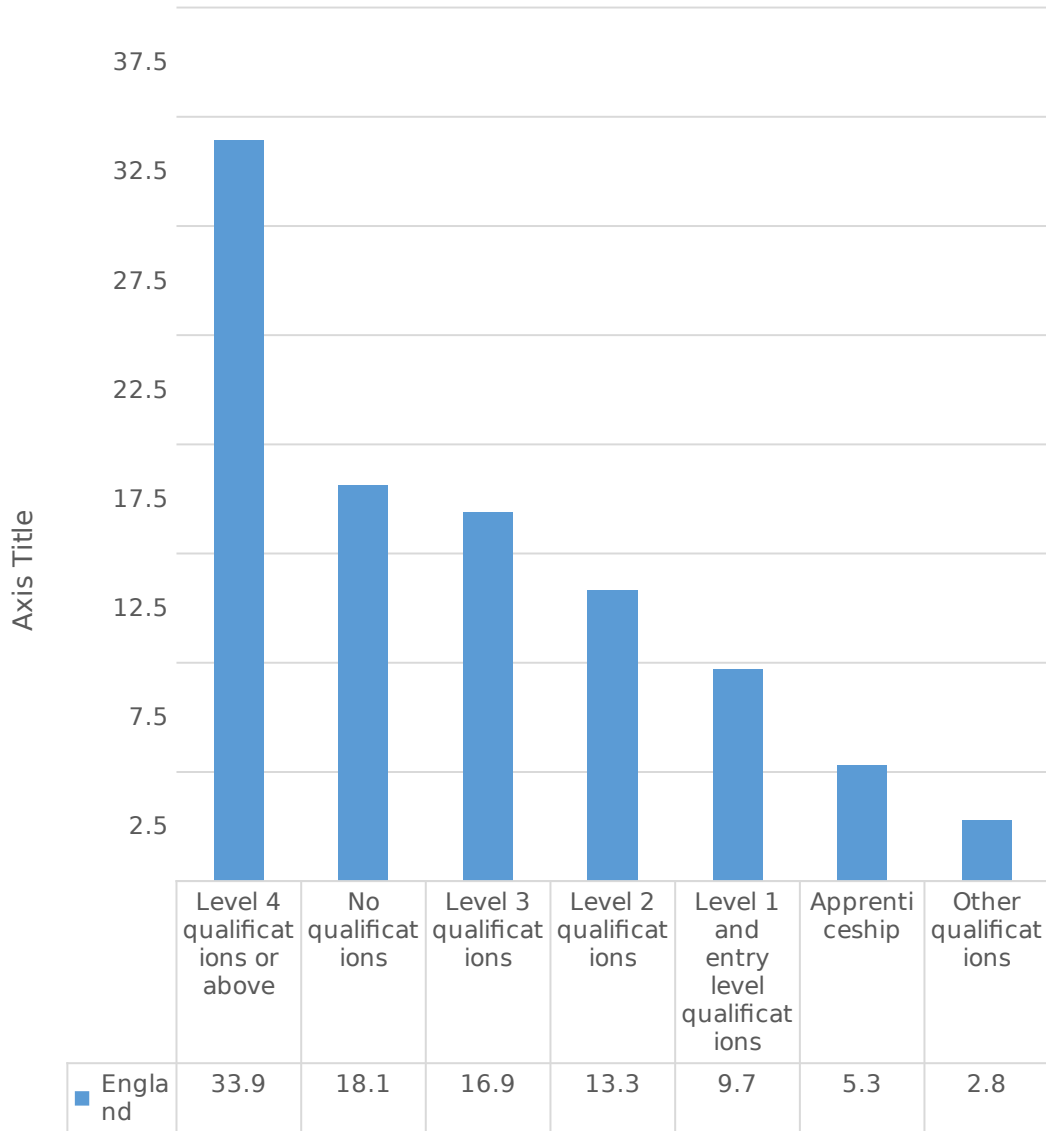
What is the highest level of education qualification you have achieved (either in England, the wider UK or elsewhere)?



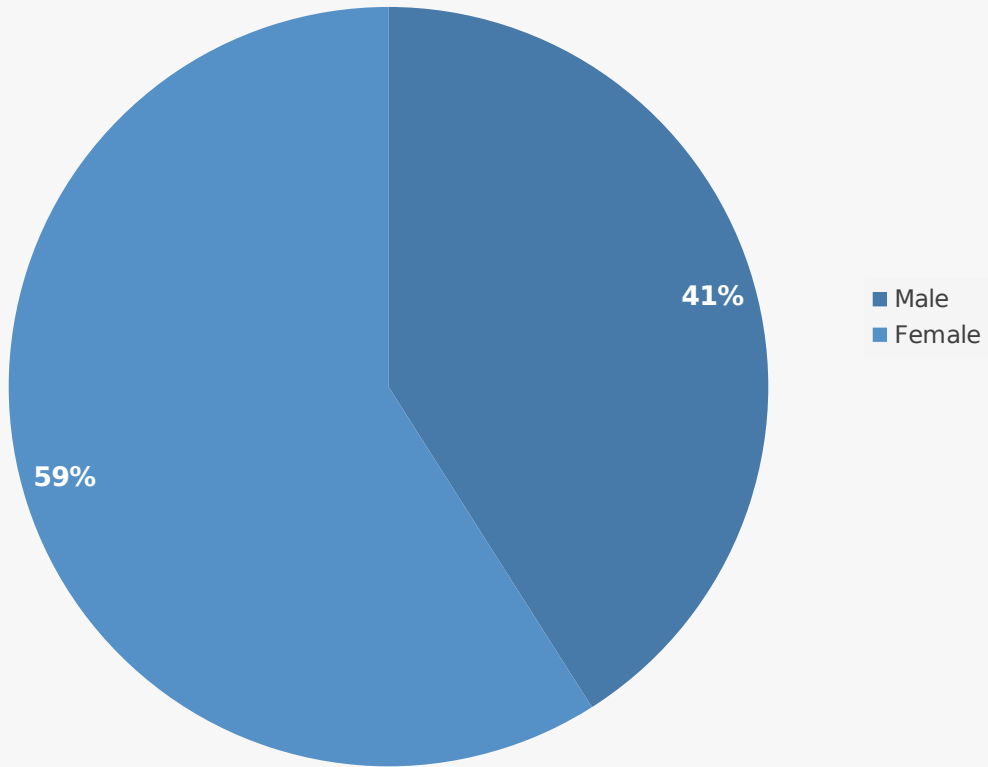

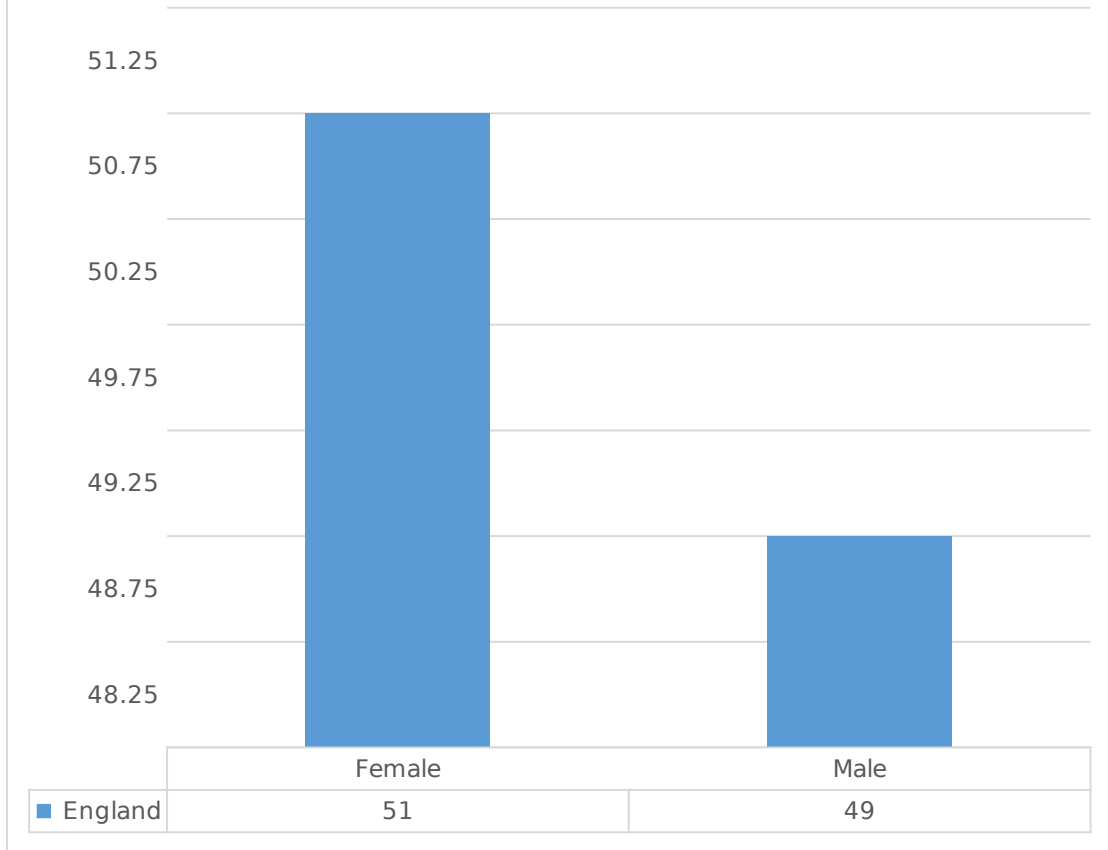


What is your sex, as registered at birth?

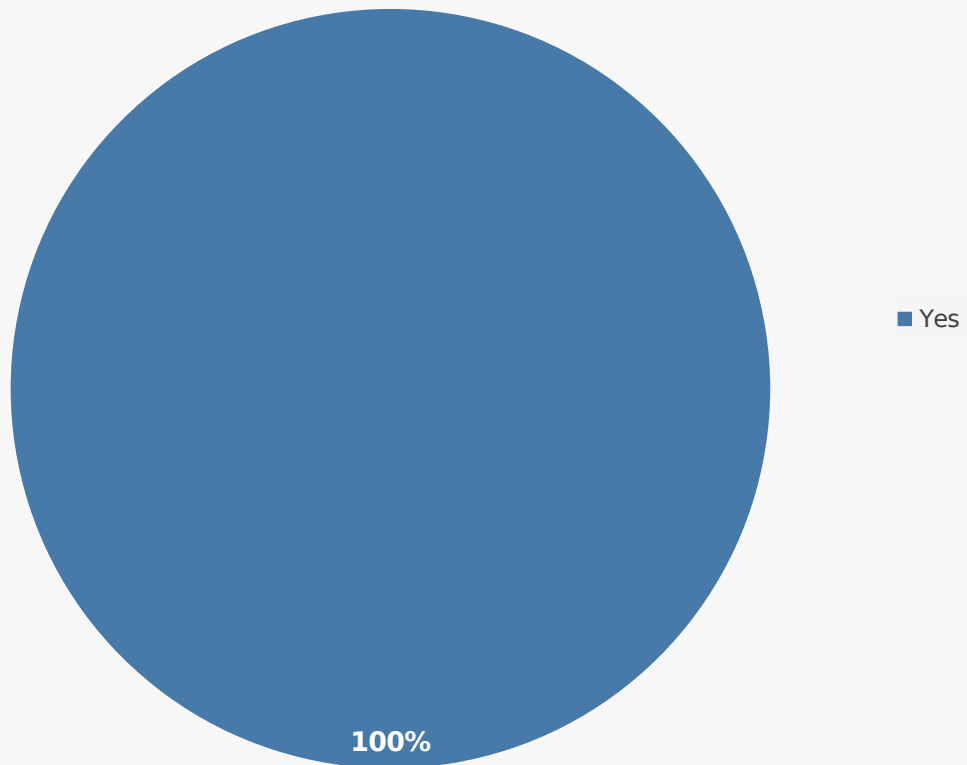

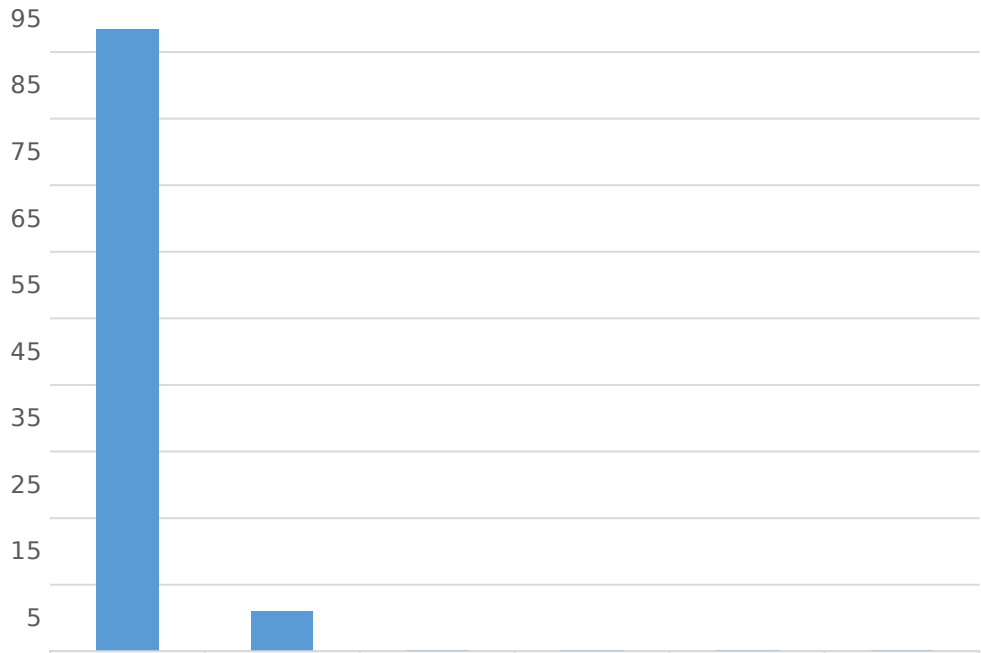


Is the gender you identify with the same as your sex registered at birth?

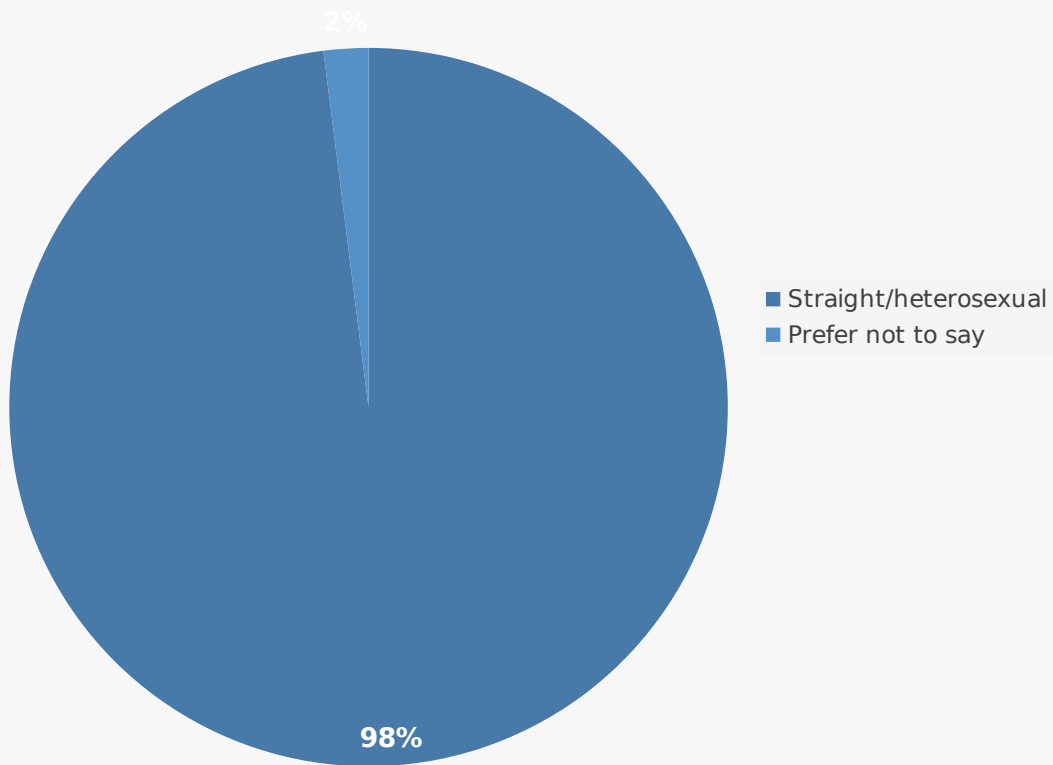
